Education in the Doctoral School of Languages and Literatures of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań is conducted on the basis of the framework educational plan and individual research plan and lasts 8 semesters.

The Doctoral School of Languages and Literatures is co-created by three faculties: Faculty of English, Faculty of Polish and Classical Philology and Faculty of Modern Languages and Literatures. PhD students at the Doctoral School of Languages and Literatures prepare a dissertation in the field of linguistics and literary studies. They are encouraged to analyze the selected literature or language in the context of culture, in particular: cinema, media, digital culture, theatre, audiovisual art, music, history, journalism. Doctoral students have extensive opportunities to participate in the cultural life of Adam Mickiewicz University and Poznań - in literary meetings, concerts of classical and popular music, theatre performances, and art exhibitions.


We have two-stage procedure for PhD candidates:
